DIVING AND CONDUCTING BUSINESS IN THE WATERS WITHIN THE DECLARED PORT BOUNDARY

Fiji Ports Corporation Limited would put on notice and advise that due to heightened security conditions in the waters within the port boundaries under its jurisdiction and to comply with International Ship and Port Security (ISPS) rules and regulations, effective forthwith **NO** commercial company or individual is allowed to carry out the following activities without prior registration and approval of Fiji Ports Corporation Limited;-

- Diving (including recreational diving),
- Wreck removal,
- Salvaging,
- Ship Demolition,
- Underwater repair works,
- On-board repairs or
- Any business involving the waters within the port boundaries

All parties intending to provide or engage with any activities/services mentioned above within the port boundaries under FPCL jurisdiction should register with FPCL as per the guidelines set forth in the company's website <http://www.fijiports.com.fj/forms/> (Registration forms can be downloaded through this link or hard copies can be obtained at the reception counter, Muaiwalu House, Walu Bay, Suva).

The deadline for registration will be **17th June 2016**. Any unregistered or unauthorized companies/individuals operating within the port boundaries beyond this date would be subject to legal action under the Sea Port Management Act 2005 and cessation of services and cancellation of port user licences without any further notice.

All companies/individuals are kindly requested to take note of the above and act in accordance with the requirements.
